- If a player's stance or swing is impeded by such a tree, the ball must be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one clublength of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole, in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16.1f.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)
 6.1 All areas marked G.U.R. or ringed in white paint or enclosed by temporary fencing, players must take relief.
